



How Providers can Become a COVID-19 Vaccinator

What's New

Health and Human Service Commission (HHSC) advises any licensed facility, organization, or healthcare provider interested in [becoming a COVID-19 vaccine provider](#), is eligible to enroll if they currently possess or administer vaccines or vaccination services.

First Step

The first step to becoming a COVID-19 vaccine provider is registering through [EnrollTexasIZ.dshs.texas.gov](#). Only providers registered through this site can receive and administer COVID-19 vaccine in Texas.

Registration Process

Each facility or location, including those that are part of a hospital or clinical network, must list the healthcare providers that will administer the vaccination (e.g. each hospital in a hospital system must complete a registration separately and list vaccine providers there).

- Register at [EnrollTexasIZ.dshs.texas.gov](#).
- Complete the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) COVID-19 Vaccination Program Provider Agreement. (**We recommend using the Google Chrome internet browser to complete the COVID-19 Provider Agreement**).

After Registration

After completing enrollment, you will receive an email confirming your registration. Once approved, you will receive another email confirming your status as a COVID-19 vaccine provider.
